

RADIO DOCUMENTARIES

• In some countries called "FEATURES"

 Until the mid-1960s radio documentaries were not very developed - primarily a studio-recorded monologue (similar to essay or reportage) recited by narrators • The Big Bang came in 1967 – Peter Leonhard Braun produced the feature called CHICKENS

• CHICKENS = the first use of a stereo technique in radio

 1974 – Peter Leonhard Braun (Germany) met Ake Blömstrom (Sweden) and Andries Poppe (Belgium) and they discussed the importance of the international cooperation • 1975 - the foundation of the International Feature Conference (IFC)

INTERNATIONAL FEATURE CONFERENCE

 An open forum for radio makers and freelancers from all over the Europe where they can discuss their work

• The main idea of the conference is to share the knowledge about the recording techniques, technologies, editing, choosing of topics, sounds - to learn from each other

INTERNATIONAL FEATURE CONFERENCE

- Travelling across all of Europe (sometimes to transatlantic countries)
- Around 100 participants
- Scripts in the English language are provided
- Only in open discussion about programs can participants learn the most interesting things and extend the boundaries of their perception of documentary making
